What are the Teenage Health Demonstration Sites?

The sites were funded by the Department of Health to develop innovative ways to improve young people's physical and emotional health services. Portsmouth, Northumberland, Hackney and Bolton were chosen to show how services can be developed in a wide variety of circumstances. Each site developed services for young people in health and community settings and also took on specific work to ensure that services reached all young people. The sites gained huge experience about building and delivering sustainable services for young people.
