



IMPACT Paediatric Bowel Care Pathway Training Day Invitation

It is estimated that 10% of all children in the UK suffer from constipation and faecal impaction and as you will know from experience, diagnosis and treatment is patchy and often inadequate. It is well recognised that children's continence services should be improved. This was reiterated in the recently published NSF for Children where the DoH states:

“An integrated community based paediatric continence service, informed by good Practice in Paediatric Continence Service, ensures that accessible, high quality assessment and treatment is provided to children and their parents/carers in any setting, including, for example, children looked after and children in boarding schools”

There is an obvious need for knowledge and training in this area and to help meet this need a group of experts, led by June Rogers MBE, have written a comprehensive paediatric bowel care pathway and training course.

The IMPACT Paediatric Bowel Care Pathway has been written by Paediatric Continence Advisors, Paediatricians, Continence Nurse Specialists, Dietitians and CAMHS (Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services) teams to help health professionals manage, in a very practical manner the problems of constipation, faecal impaction and soiling in children. Both the ACA and the RCN have endorsed the IMPACT Paediatric Bowel Care Pathway.

We plan to hold this one-day course on the IMPACT Paediatric Bowel Care Pathway on Tuesday 27th November 2007, at the Cedar Court Hotel, Wakefield. An independent leader in the field of paediatric bowel care will lecture on your course and we can accommodate 20-30 delegates per course. Ideally you will be able to take what you have learnt and implement and share the information with your colleagues to improve patient care.

On the course it is envisioned that the course leader will ‘train the trainers’ in anatomy and physiology, diagnosis and treatment. You will take away a comprehensive IMPACT Bowel Care Pathway that contains almost everything you need to successfully set up and run a Paediatric Continence Clinic or improve your current working practices, plus a full training pack to help you train your own team.
